Wildlife Emergency Response Fund

Humane Society International is an avid supporter of wildlife carers and the incredible work they do to preserve our native species across Australia. Our Wildlife Land Trust program includes over 600 sanctuaries, many of which are wildlife rehabilitation or release sites.

Sadly, dedicated wildlife carers are among those most devastated by the fires, droughts and floods affecting Australia and those most in need of help in this trying time. Even after the danger has passed, many wildlife carers remain inundated with many animals in need of care and few suitable release sites.

We have set up an Emergency Fund and are offering support to any registered wildlife carer who needs assistance in the wake of these disasters.

At this stage we have delivered funding for ongoing food and water costs; provided wildlife rehabilitation equipment including ICUs, fruit-cutting machines and water pumps; and helped to fund new enclosures to support larger numbers of animals in care.
